

# Geoffrey Bay Vine Scrub Plant Species List 2022

## Re-survey of Geoffrey Bay Vine scrub - January 2022

The Geoffrey Bay Vine Scrub was originally surveyed in 1993 by Rod Fensham, when 39 species of woody plant (including vines) were recorded. Since then, the scrub appears to have increased in species richness, with 50 woody plants recorded in 2022 (three native herbaceous species were also added to the list as they were considered typical vine forest gap species – bringing the total to 53 species).

Interestingly there were five shrubs (*Eugenia reinwardtiana*, *Memecylon pauciflorum* var. *pauciflorum*, *Micromelum minutum*, *Myrsine variabilis* and *Pavetta australiensis*) and one vine (*Pisonia aculeata*) that were not found in 2022. The missing shrubs are species more typical of drier, more open scrubs, or transitional forest, so these may have been shaded out by the developing canopy. The vine may simply be difficult to detect amongst the tall vine towers.

The scrub is in good condition with very few exotics within the bulk of the scrub itself, so clearly the weeding programme over the years has been successful.
